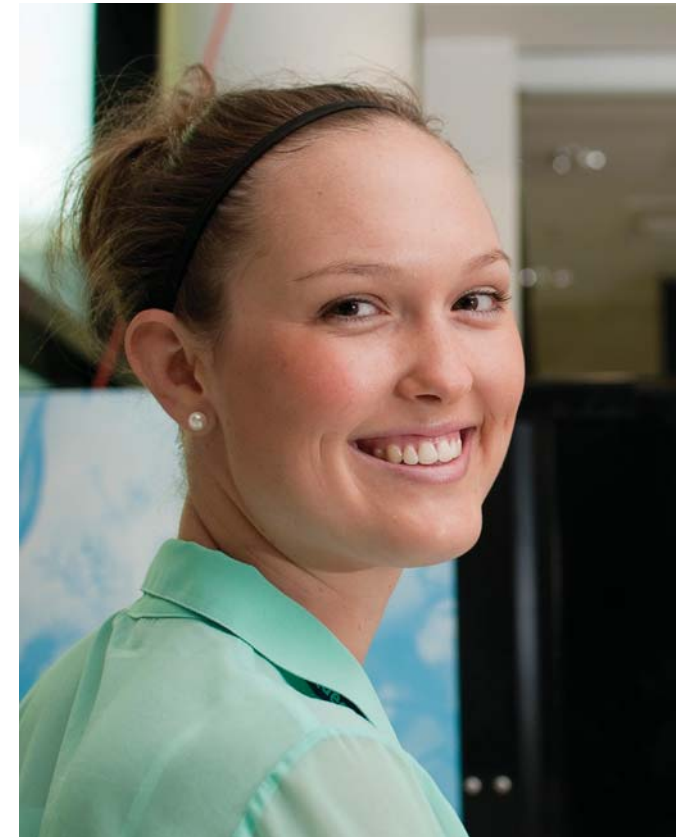

Group programs

Back in Control

A six session education program for people who have or have had a drug/alcohol related problem. Certificate provided on completion.

ADAPT

A dual diagnosis specific ACT based therapy program made up of eleven 2 hour sessions. Facilitated by specialist trained professionals. Participants can self-refer & require an assessment.

SCRAP Book

A six session self conducted, home-based education program for people who have or have had a drug/alcohol concern and who live within the Gold Coast. Statement of Completion can be provided.
