AIM stands for "Allied In Motion". Our mission is to provide contemporary evidence based practice, incorporating a multi-disciplinary approach for superior health outcomes. Primarily, our services are provided in-home, but we also have access to multiple clinics around the Gold Coast.

AIM Rehab provides inter-disciplinary support for:

AIM Rehab has developed the Gold Coast Falls Risk Assessment Tool (GC-FRAT). This assessment is used to identify individual falls risk, and provides an outcome score based on several parameters. AIM identified 21 assessment criteria to investigate physical, social, environmental and cognitive domains. The outcome score allows our therapist's to accurately target risk areas and develop treatment strategies for improved stability. A copy of the GC-FRAT can be found in the documents below.

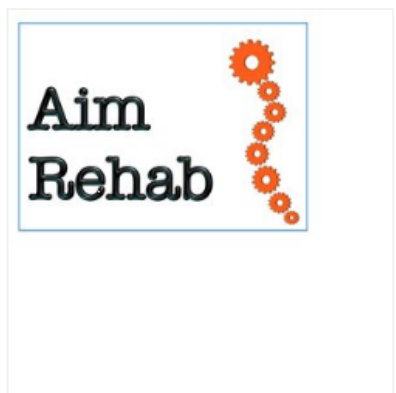
