

# ALCOHOL

Depressant on the central nervous system  
Also known as grogg, piss, liquor, nip, charge

## Intoxication

Slurred Speech	Slow Reflexes
Drowsy	Memory Loss
Nausea	Unsteady on their feet
Vomiting	Passing Out
Smell of Alcohol	Dishevelled

## Withdrawal

Sweating	Nausea
Delirium Tremors (DTs)	Anxiety
Irritability	Difficulty Sleeping
Seizures or fits	Delusions
Hallucinations	Possible death

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# BENZODIAZEPINES

Depressant on the central nervous system  
Most commonly prescribed to relieve stress and anxiety and to help individuals sleep  
Also known as Benzos, sleepers, downers, pills

## Intoxication

Confusion	Dry Mouth
Forgetful	Slurred Speech
Mood Swings	Aggression
Impaired Co-ordination	Disinhibited

## Withdrawal

Stomach Pains	Paranoia
Aching /twitching Muscles	Dizziness
Tremors	Bizarre Dreams
Nausea	Poor Concentration
Vomiting	Anxiety+ irritability,
Seizures	Delusions

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# CANNABIS

Depressant on the central nervous system  
Main active chemical is THC (delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol)  
Also known as marijuana, yarndi, pot, weed, dope, cone

## Intoxication

Clumsiness	Slower Reflexes
Blood-shot Eyes	Poor hygiene
Mild Anxiety and Paranoia	Dry mouth
Increased Appetite	Sleepy
Small Pupils	Relaxed
Regular Colds	Reduced Sex Drive

## Withdrawal

Irritability	Aggressive
Loss of Appetite	Sweating
Chills	Restless Sleep
Nightmares	

# HEROIN

Depressant on the central nervous system  
Usually injected, can be smoked ('chasing the dragon')  
Also known as smack, gear, H, harry, china white, hammer

## Intoxication

Falling Asleep ('on the nod')	Itchiness
Difficulty Urinating	Constipation
Small Pupils	Cold and Clammy
Decreased Sex Drive	Overdose
Death	

## Withdrawal

Stomach and Leg Cramps	Vomiting
Depression and Crying	No appetite
Hot and Cold Flushes	Diarrhoea
Nausea	Irritability
Aching Muscles	Restlessness

# CODEINE

Depressant on the central nervous system  
Part of the opioids group used for relief of pain and cold and flu symptoms when mixed with antihistamines and decongestants

## Intoxication

Dry Mouth	Itchiness
Difficulty Urinating	Constipation
Small Pupils	Sweating
Confusion	Decreased heart rate
Decreased Sex Drive	

## Withdrawal

Stomach and Leg Cramps	Vomiting
Depression and Crying	No appetite
Hot and Cold Flushes	Diarrhoea
Nausea	Aching muscles
Difficulty Sleeping	Restlessness
Irritability	Depression

# FENTANYL

Depressant on the central nervous system  
Part of the opioids group used for chronic severe pain as a result of cancer nerve damage, back injury, major trauma or other causes  
Also known as Transdermal patches (Durogesic), Lozenges (Actiq) and IV injection (Sublimaze)

## Intoxication

Weakness	Relief from Pain
Slow pulse	Lowered Blood Pressure
Mood instability	Slurred Speech
Rash	Impaired Balance
Dizziness	Sweating
Decreased Libido	Decreased heart rate

## Withdrawal

Depression	Pain in Bones and Muscle
Insomnia	Hot and Cold Flushes
No appetite	Yawning
Watery Eyes	Runny Nose
Vomiting	Diarrhoea
